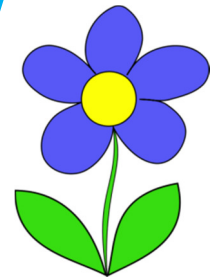
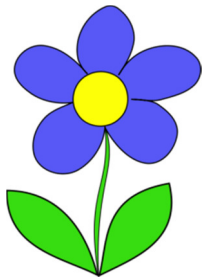


Spring Term 2017
