2017-18 results:

Data shows that St. Joseph's Catholic Primary School is above the National Average for children reaching the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths. The school is also well above the NA for children achieving Greater Depth (of Higher Standard HS) in Reading and Writing.

The Year 6 cohort (2017-18) achieved higher than the National Average for Reading, Writing and Maths combined.

Particular strengths can be seen in the attainment in Reading and Writing and the progress that pupils made from KS1 to the end of KS2 ie. the 'Value Added' Average – which shows children have made particular progress from their starting points.

The school continues to support children well in their learning and children are happy and enthusiastic about their work.
