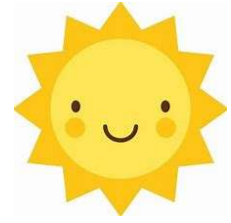


Life in Class 3

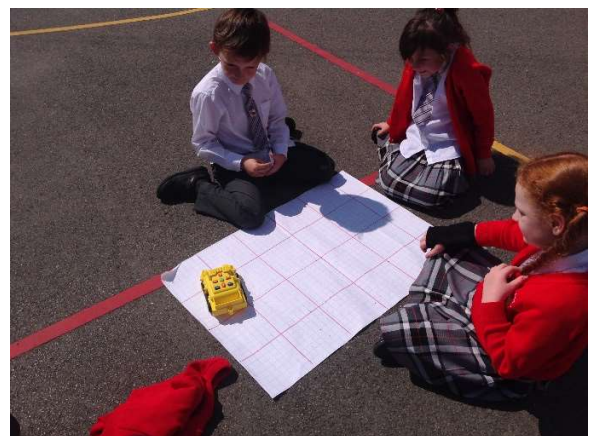
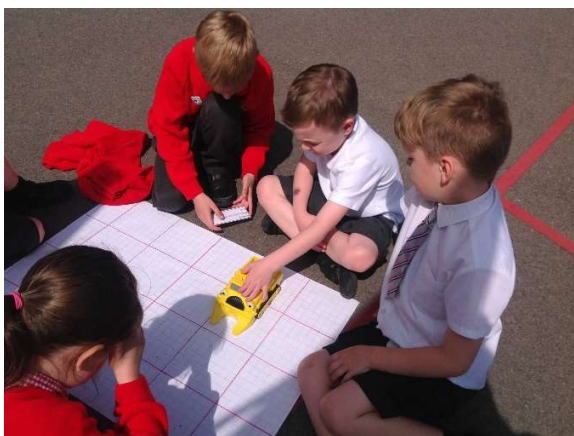


We had a visit from 'Destination Judo' and we got to take part in a Judo class. We learnt some new skills and we really enjoyed ourselves.
