2018-19 results:

Data shows that St. Joseph's Catholic Primary School is well above the National Average for children reaching the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths. The school is also well above the NA for children achieving Greater Depth (of Higher Standard HS) in Reading and Writing.

The Year 6 cohort (2018-19) achieved higher than the National Average for Reading, Writing and Maths combined – 100% of children achieving the standard in all three areas, placing the school in the top 10% across the country. Well done everyone!

'Value Added' Averages also shows that the children have made very good progress from KS1 – with averages well above NA of 0.

The school continues to support children well in their learning and children are happy and enthusiastic about their work.
