### 2018-19 results:

Data shows that St. Joseph's Catholic Primary School **is well above** the National Average for children reaching the expected standard in **Reading, Writing and Maths**. The school is also **well above** the NA for children achieving Greater Depth (of Higher Standard HS) **in Reading and Writing**.

The Year 6 cohort (2018-19) achieved higher than the National Average for Reading, Writing and Maths combined – 100% of children achieving the standard in all three areas, placing the school in the top 10% across the country. Well done everyone!

'Value Added' Averages also shows that the children have made very good progress from KS1 – with averages well above NA of 0.

*The school continues to support children well in their learning and children are happy and enthusiastic about their work.*
