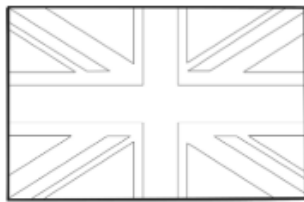

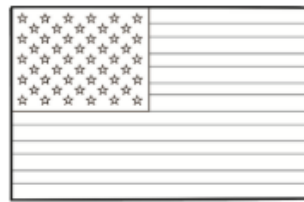

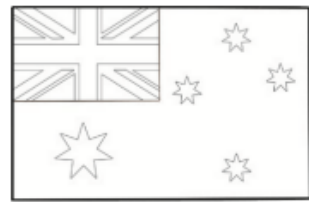

Emil is saving up his pound coins to travel the world. He says, 'the tens digit is half of 10. The ones digit is even. The thousands digit is 2. The tens digit is one more than the ones digit. The hundreds digit is the same as the sum of the thousands and ones digit.' How many pound coins does Emil have?

Chen and Aamir have been counting their holiday money. Who has the most amount of money?

Chen

The ones digit is more than the thousands digit. The total of the digits is ten. The difference between the digits is 4. The thousands digit is the same as $1 + 2$. The hundreds digit is half of 6.'

Aamir

The total of the hundreds and thousands digits is 8. The tens digit is odd. The tens digit is a multiple of 3. The ones digit is seven less than the tens digit. The hundreds and thousands digits are the same.

Ralph is on holiday and wants to hire a boat for a week. The boat company tells him the hire cost is a four-digit number where the digit sum of the tens and ones digit is 5. It is less 2 thousand. What could the hire cost be?

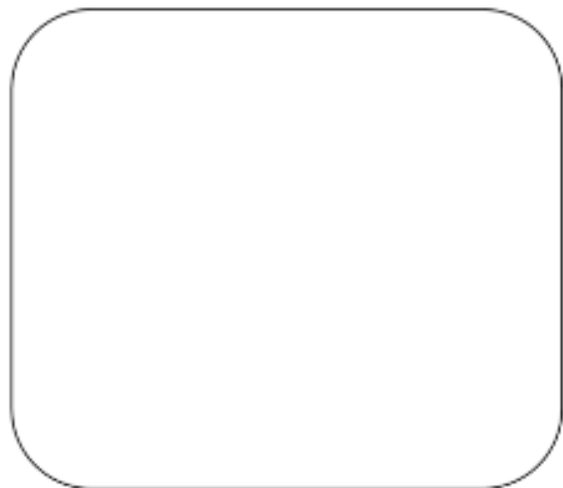
