This week we are stepping away from Traditional Tales for the week as, this year marks an extra special Victory in Europe (VE) Day on 8th May 2020 (This Friday).


Since we cannot be together to celebrate the 75th Anniversary of VE Day in school. I have designed this week's tasks all around this to help you learn about it at home!

Writing Ideas

- Research VE Day and write about what it is, when it was, how many years it is this year, why we celebrate, what it means for the country etc.
- Look at the picture below, what do you think is happening? Who is there? What do you think they are celebrating? Why are things red, white and blue? Do you think it would have been fun?
- Pretend you were alive on VE Day write a letter to a friend telling them all about the Victory and the celebrations.
- Victory in Europe was famously announced by Radio broadcast plan, write and record your own radio broadcast to tell the country of the Victory!
- Write a fact file about VE including all of the key dates and information.
- Write a diary entry of VE Day how did you feel? What did you do?
- Plan a tea party for you and your family at home to celebrate on Friday you could write invitations, a menu, posters to advertise etc.
