

Home Learning Tasks W.b. 18.05.2020



Hello Year 1,

Well done for continuing to stay at home and work hard! You are all doing so well and I am a very proud teacher! Seeing all of your work is keeping me busy and making me smile!

This week we are continuing with 'Jack and The Beanstalk' and we are going to work to create our own versions.

You can continue to access the Twinkl Go resources including the story PowerPoint and audio book for you to use if you don't have this story at home! There is also a word mat and some fun interactive Jack and The Beanstalk themed activities on there too! These are available using the same code as last week.

## Suggested Writing Ideas:

You can be as creative as you like with these activities – the more creative and imaginative you are on each task, the better your story will be at the end of the week!

- Monday Think of a new character that Jack will meet when he gets to the top of the bean stalk. This time it won't be the giant who will it be? Make sure you draw a picture of your character first showing all of their features etc. Use your picture to help you write a description of them and don't forget to give them a name!
- Tuesday Now that you have a new character we are going to design a new setting. Think of a new magical land to get to at the top of the beanstalk. Think could be anything you like a tree house, chocolate world, jungle, candy floss land think creatively! Draw or make your magical land first and then use this to write all about it. Remember to use your senses to describe your setting e.g in the magical land I can see...
- Wednesday When Jack goes up the bean stalk he brings three things back, a hen, a golden harp and golden eggs! In your story Jack has to get in to your magical land, passed you new character to collect three new things that his mum would be please with! Think of the three new things and explain why he took these e.g he took a magical potion that can keep you healthy.
- Thursday Think about what will happen in your story with your new character, setting and items. Draw a picture plan of the main events in your story, remember to use a structure including a beginning, middle and end.
- Friday Using all of your planning over the week, write a new version of Jack and The Beanstalk. Remember to include your new characters, magical land and items! Remember take your time and write a beginning, middle and end!

## Reading/Phonics:

It is important to keep reading whilst at home! Keep accessing your school books and word wallets. Remember you can find more E-books at your reading level on Oxford Owl. Let me know if you need a hand finding your reading level on there! You can also access Phonics Play that we use in School, for free at home at the moment! Try and play some games on here each day to practice your sounds!
