Suggested Structure:

Monday – Read the story and get to know what happens! Today you can sequence what happens in the story and write the key events. I will send you sequencing images of the story on Class Dojo!

Tuesday – Re-read this week's story. Pick one of the toys to write about. Today I would like you to write a fact file about the toy! I have attached a template to this document to help you!

Wednesday – Planning day – I would like you to think about a new adventure that Lottie can get up to. Today you can make a plan, write your ideas, key parts, what she will do, where she will go, what she will see etc! Remember this can be in note form on a spider diagram!

Thursday – Write Lottie's next adventure!

Friday – Reading comprehension! Reread the story from this week and answer the questions about the story!
