To start the academic year we recapped numbers within 20. We have been using practical resources to partition numbers within twenty, using the story of the tens and ones house. The ones knock on the door and are invited to live in the ones house but when there are 9 there are too many so they have to move next door to live in the tens house. We really enjoyed this story!





We have also been practising adding and taking away using resources such as counters and numicon. We have improved our understanding of how to read and write +, - and = signs.

We have also been learning about half.
We have investigated finding two equal
parts of a shape and a quantity.



To learn about shapes, we went on a shape hunt around school to identify 2D shapes in objects around us. We also investigated the odd one out in groups of shapes.









We continued looking at representing two digit numbers. We also continued the story of tens and ones to further explore two digit numbers.



We investigated making number bonds to 10 and 20. We used addition mats to explore how to make a given number and solve problems.



To further develop our knowledge of adding and subtraction within 20 we crossed 10 using resources and drawings. This will also help us adding and subtracting across 10 mentally.









We also started learning about time! We ordered days of the week and months of the year. We also practised telling the time to the nearest hour and used our knowledge to solve problems.




We have also been learning about common and proper nouns and which of these need capital letters and why. We have been practising our tricky words and correcting sentences that don't start with capital letters.

We have been writing diary entries! First we looked at the features of a diary in examples. We also learnt more about verbs and how to say and write these in the past tense, which most of the time means using Uncle Ed.

our dairy entries.




Class 2: Science Autumn 1

This term we have been learning all about our senses! We have been investigating using our senses, here are some of our investigations:

To investigate smelling we had to close our eyes and identify if we liked a smell or not. We then looked at the results of the whole class to find which was the groups' favourite and least favourite smell!

To explore sight we discussed how our sight changes in the dark and we looked at how our partners pupils changed when the light changed. We discussed and watched videos about the importance of sight!





To investigate hearing, we went on a sound walk around school. We used our sense of sound to describe and compare the sounds.



To investigate touch we played games where we had to find an object in a box without looking and we used a paper clip to write a letter on our partners back. We explored different textures and described them.

We had to close our eyes and taste something without looking. This was a fun experiment! We then described the different tastes to compare them.

First we learnt about the different diets animals have: herbivore, omnivore and carnivore.








We learnt we are mammals! We identified what the features of a mammal are.

We learnt more about the role of our God Parents and also about our role as a member of the Church.





We also made advent wreaths with 4 candles to represent the 4 weeks we count down to Christmas.














We learnt about the story and symbolism of the Christingle through making our own.













Class 2: DT Autumn 1

- 6. The last step was to review our healthy snack against our design criteria. Then we thought about how we could improve our product to make it even better.




















Class 2: Art Autumn 2

This term we have been exploring using paint and painting portraits!



- 1. First we explored the textures of different types of paint. We used adjectives to describe how they were similar and different.
- We also identified primary colours. We then used these to explore how to make secondary colours.





- 5. We then used a self-portrait guide and drew ourselves. We then used water colour to paint our portraits.
- 6. We also looked at the work of Yayoi Kasumi. She used lots of bright colours and patterns and we used different tools such as rollers to create our own bright and bold, patterned background.

Class 2: Geography Autumn 1

We have been learning about the weather in our local area.



To identify what the weather is like in Murton, we kept a weather diary and used weather symbols to complete it. We also measured the weather by making a wind vain and a rain gauge.





We also roleplayed being a meteorologist and we used weather symbols over a map of Murton to do a weather forecast.











We also conducted some field research and we went around our school to find human and physical features around us. To further explore Murton, we identified human and physical features using a map and looking at the symbols.



Class 2: History Autumn 2

We have been learning about ordering events in our past.

To start the unit we learnt the key words past, present and future and applied these to our own lives.

We ordered events from our past such as starting school, our 4th birthday and starting Year

We also looked at artefacts from our past, we identified what they could tell us about our past and we compared this to the present.





We also learnt about the Gun Powder plot. We created a fact file about the event and also role-played what happened.





Every year we burn bonfires and put a model of Guy Fawkes on top. We light fireworks and sparklers and celebrate the failure of the Gunpowder Plot.

Class 2: PE, Music, IT Autumn 1

PE

In PE, we have been practising basic movement skills. We have been learning about why we warm up and cool down also. We have practised running, jumping, skipping, rolling, throwing and catching and controlling a ball and we have applied these skills into games. We have also practised balancing and using co-ordination.

Music

We have really been enjoying Music lessons! In Music, we have been learning to continue a rhythm pattern with different parts of our bodies. We have been learning songs about Autumn, about travelling and we also learnt a song using sign language too!
