Autumn Term 2020

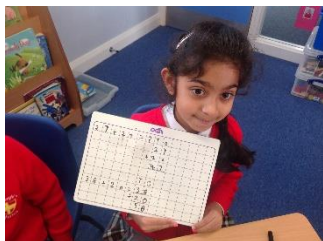


What a busy Autumn Term we have had! We have all enjoyed being back in school learning and having fun.

We followed instructions for how to make a superhero stick puppet and shield before writing our own instructions to help someone else to follow.



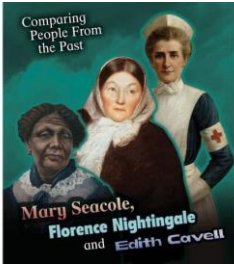

We used the Paint Programme to learn how to use different tools. We developed our skills and even created our own Computer Pop Art.

We took part in 'Tree Planting' and planted a tree each in the school grounds.

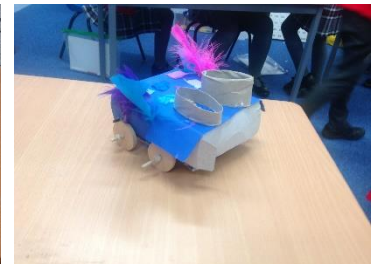


We shared a delicious Christmas Dinner with our class bubble!
