Spring Term 2021

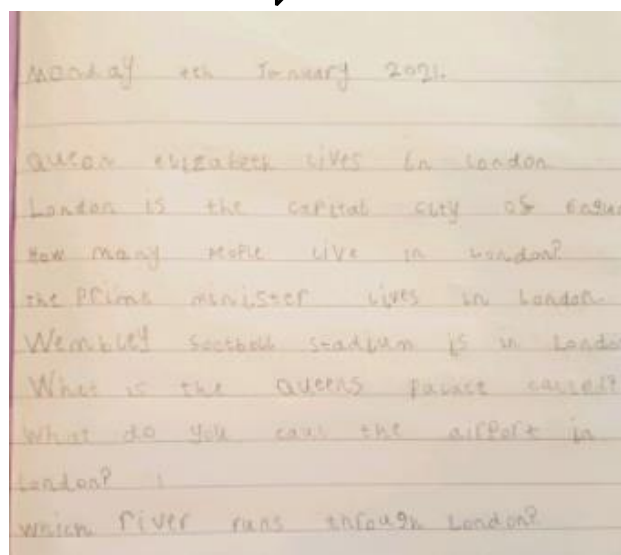


Spring Term 2021 didn't start the way we all wanted as we headed into another Lockdown and another period of Remote Learning.


However, Year 2 took to live lessons online like absolute pros! It was so lovely to see everyone's smiling faces via MS Teams while we tackled the next stage of our learning together.

Our topic for Spring 1 was about London. We started our topic by reading 'Katie in London' and finding out about lots of London landmarks.


We worked on recognising and using different sentence types by writing questions about London and then statements to answer the questions.



We wrote setting descriptions of London describing what Katie saw on her London adventure.






Dear Diary

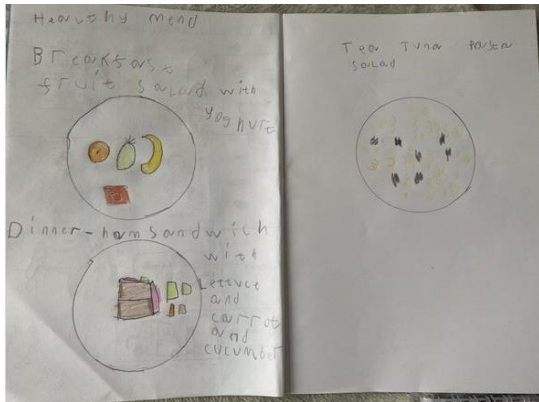

Think of five exercise activities. How many times can you do the exercise in one minute. How does the exercise make your body feel?

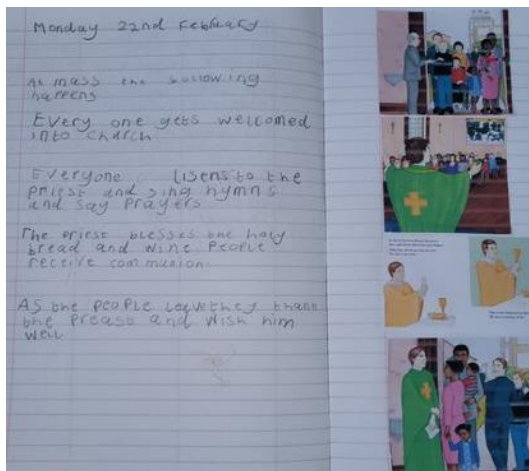

We continued our Music lessons with Miss Parker each week.

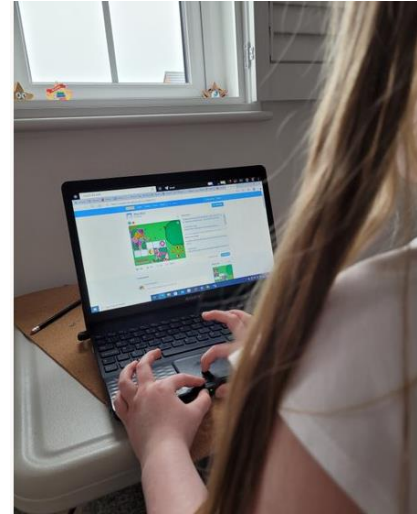


In R.E we learnt about 'Books' and 'Thanksgiving'.

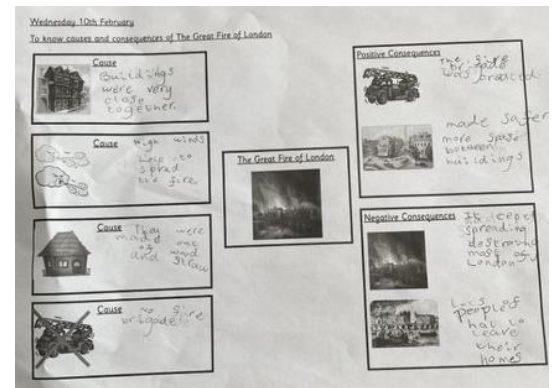
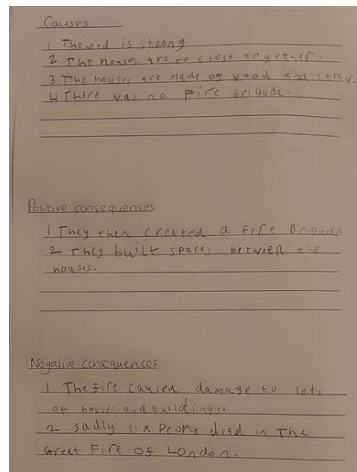

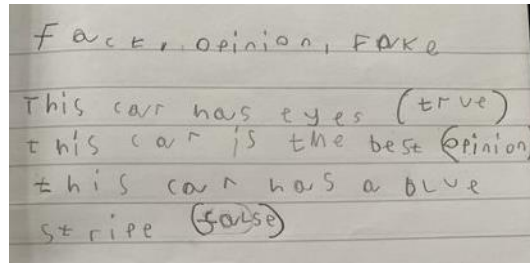
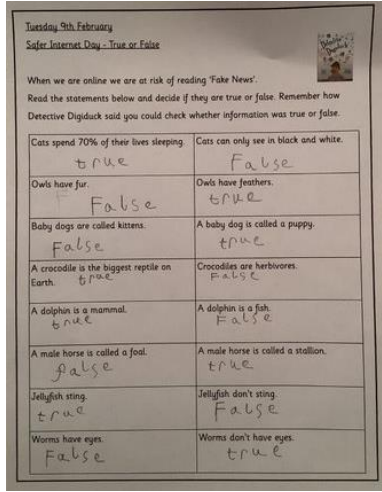
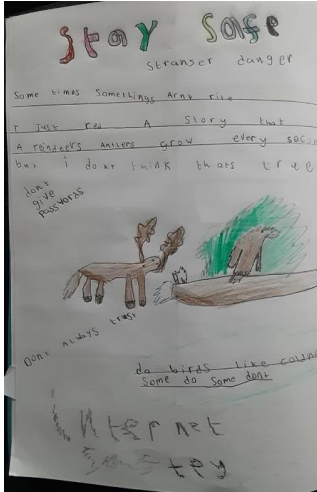
In our Computing work we continued to look at algorithms using Beebot games online and Barefoot Computing.



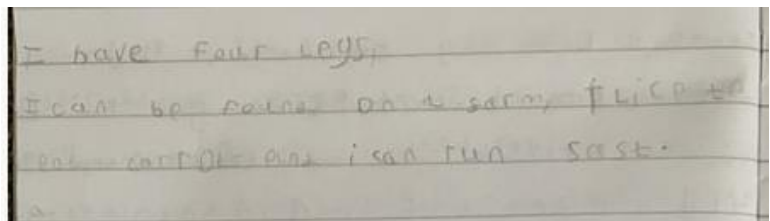
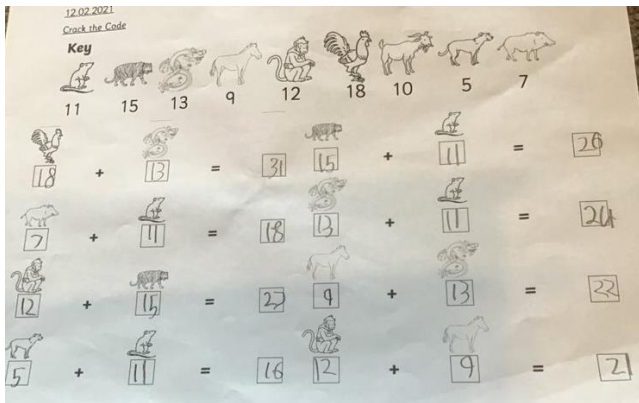
Year 2 particularly enjoyed finding out about The Great Fire of London and could explain the causes and effects of the terrible fire.



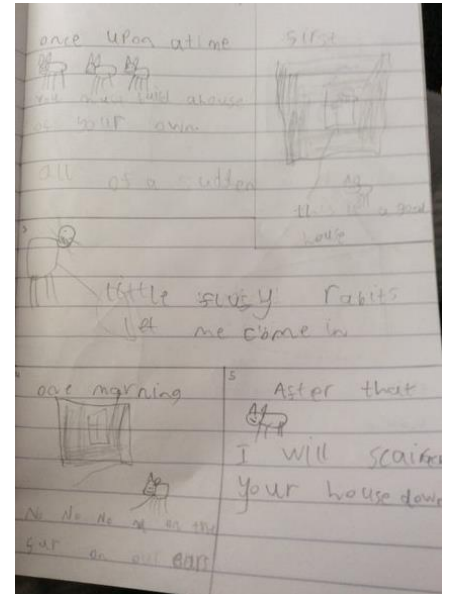
We took part in 'Safer Internet Day' and learnt about why all the information we read online may not be true – 'Fake News'.



We all celebrated Chinese New Year!

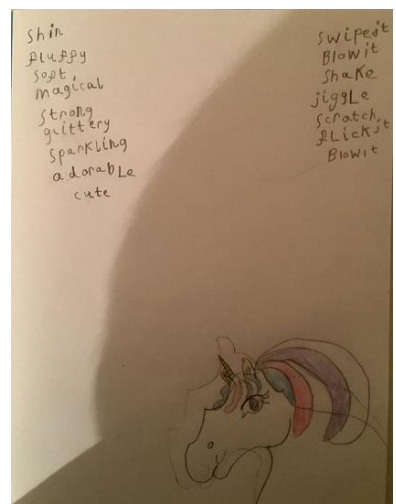


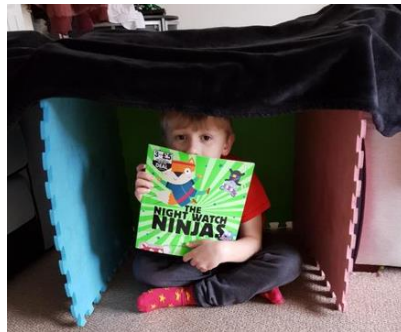
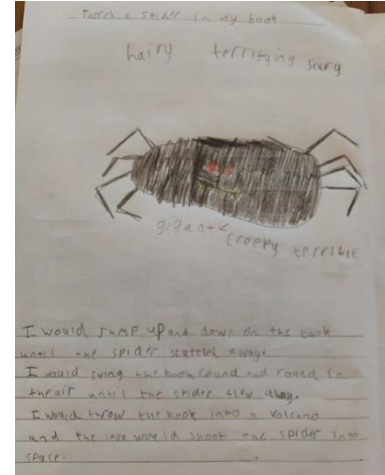
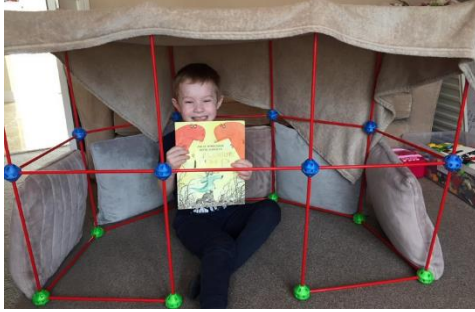
