

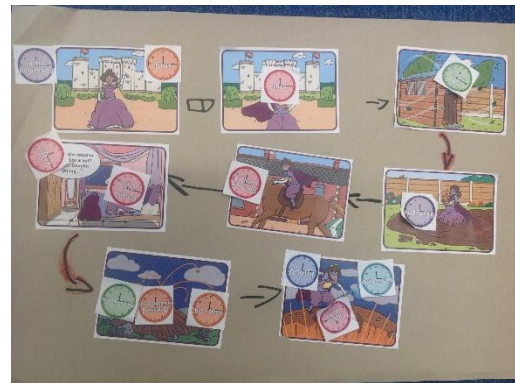


Life in Class 3

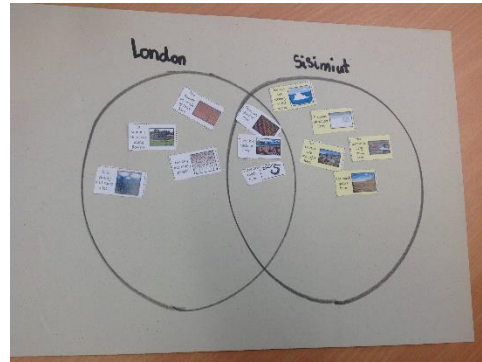
