



## School Data for 2022.

### Phonics Screening Results 2022:

Year 1 Phonic screening results indicate that 65% of pupils in Y1 in the academic year 2021-22 were working at the expected standard.

Year 2 Phonics 100% of pupils achieved the expected standard.

### 2021-22 results:

Data shows that St. Joseph's Catholic Primary School KS2 data is **below** the National Average for children reaching the expected standard in **Reading and Maths** and **above the NA in Writing**.

This can be partially attributed to the disruption in education caused by COVID-19, disapplication of pupils and pupil mobility.

The school is also **below** the NA for children achieving Greater Depth (of Higher Standard HS) in **Reading and Maths** and in line for **Writing**.

'Value Added' Averages shows that the children have made good progress from KS1 in Writing – with the average above NA of 0.

*The school continues to support children well in their learning and children are happy and enthusiastic about their work.*
